Classroom Management & Designing Classroom Spaces

This workshop combines classroom management and design principles. Participants will work with a framework for creating a classroom management plan that includes preventing problems, taking action when problems arise and intervening with individual students. This framework allows teachers to create a flexible management plan that accommodates different strategies and teaching styles.
